

MINUTES OF THE PATTINGHAM AND PATSHULL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THE 9TH DECEMBER AT PATTINGHAM VILLAGE HALL

149/24. Apologies for Absence.

- He has been lucky enough to get Highways to come out and meet on site to look at the issues for Perton and they are waiting for this meeting to be rescheduled at Pittingham.
- Flooding is still a very big issue especially due to the storms.
- Burnhill Green – resurfacing of the road under warranty, when are they coming back to repair the warrantied work, he will chase this item.

155/24. Update on Tennis court update and any other related playing field issues

A quote for the extra green surface painting and lines for the tennis courts has been requested from Fosse and also another supplier.

Fosse have quoted costs to lightly clean, colour coat the entire court surfaces and line mark the 2Nr. courts as existing would be £4740.00 + vat in total. They are happy to cover 50% of the above cost, which would leave a balance of £2370.00 + vat for Pittingham Parish Council to pay.

A second quote is awaited.

It was agreed to ask the contractor to look at removing the kissing gate section in part and get a price to make the existing the gate close safely in addition to the quote received for the access off West Beech Road to the playing fields.
